Dear Permittee:

The Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission (Commission) is authorized to administer and enforce the provisions of the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Code (Code), and the rules adopted by the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission to implement the Code (Rules).

This Notice of Violation is issued against your establishment by the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission based on the following alleged facts and/or conduct:

1. On or about September 10, 2015, Respondent, its agent, servant or employee, without first obtaining a permit, manufactured, distilled, brewed, sold, possessed for the purpose of sale, import into this state, export from this state, transport, distribute, warehouse or stored liquor, in violation the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Code §§ 11.01(a)(1) and 11.61(b)(7).
2. On or about September 21, 2015, Respondent, its agent, servant or employee, possessed equipment or material designed for, capable of use for, or used in manufacturing an illicit beverage, in violation the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Code §§ 11.61(b)(1) and 103.02.

As a result of this violation the Commission intends to cancel or suspend your permit, deny or refuse the approval of your original or renewal application. Before the Commission takes the proposed action against your permit you have an opportunity to show you are in compliance with all requirements of law for the retention of your permit and/or the opportunity to resolve this matter informally.

If you wish to take advantage of the opportunity to show compliance and/or resolve this

matter informally, you must contact me at Austin (512) 206-3490 within 10 days from the date on this letter.

If you fail to contact the Commission on or before this time, a formal action to cancel or suspend your permit will be filed before the State Office of Administrative Hearings. You will receive a separate Notice of Hearing if a formal administrative action is filed, giving you the time, date and place of your hearing. If you fail to appear for the formal hearing, the Commission may enter a default order cancelling or suspending your permit.

You are encouraged to hire a private attorney if you believe you need assistance in this matter.
